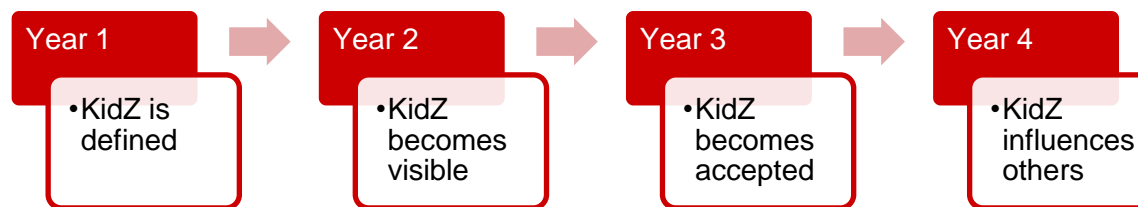

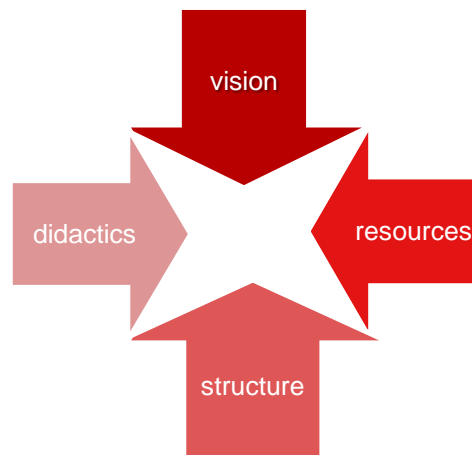


The Austrian KidZ project

KidZ (“classroom of the future”) is an innovative educational project initiated by the Federal Ministry of Education and Women in Austria. It covers the years 2013-2017 and aims at making learning with ICT part of regular school life, thus fundamentally modernizing and adjusting didactics to the requirements of the world students live in. The 4 phases of KidZ are:
