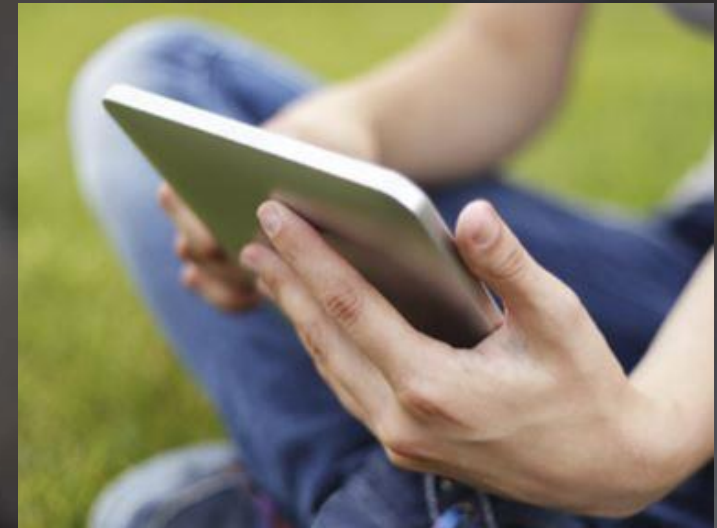


### The ZLI ...

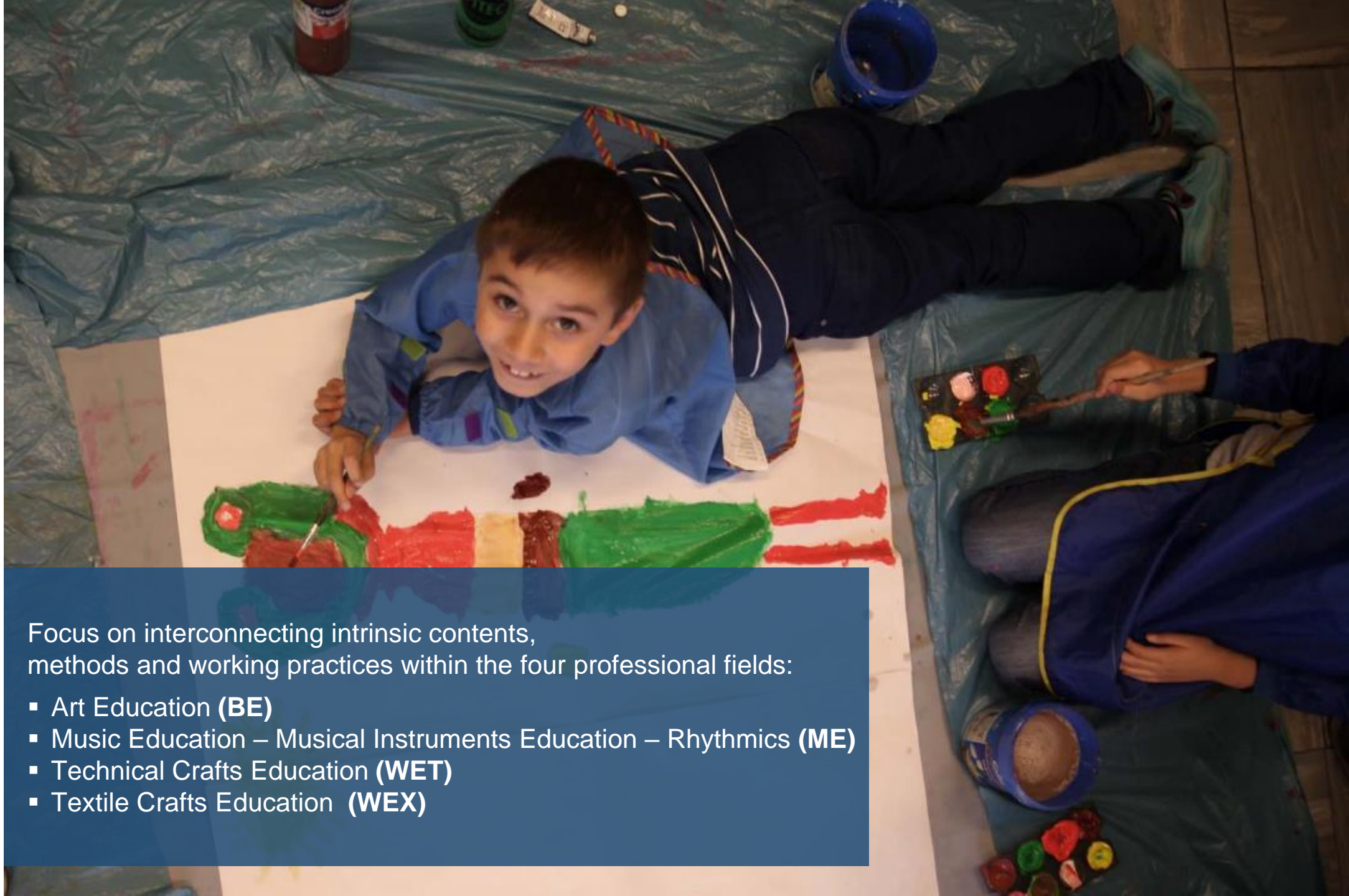
